

Tamworth interview with Jodie Compton on 28 December 2024:

JC: We're very grateful for Dr John Wilson coming all this way and to say g'day and to share his invaluable information that we all need to get our rights back, and he's brought his wonderful book "*Jackals of Slavery and How to Defeat Them*" and also "*Banks and Judges*" by John Wilson, a citizen of the Commonwealth of Australia, and "*All that it takes for evil to triumph is for good people to do nothing*" as per Sir Edmund Burke. And we're very grateful and we'll hand over to John now for him to share the information that we all need, better, better information, better choices and we can get our rights back. Take it away John.

JW: Thanks. This has been a long hard fight against very powerful opposition who ... in fact my second book is about slavery and that's what it's all about. They do not let us be, to be free men and have knowledge of what we're doing and how to govern ourselves. They want to be the masters with us as ignorant slaves, they can do whatever they like to us. They can throw us in jail and they can take our property and they can ruin our lives and our families. But once we know that we are free men and have the inalienable rights from the creator - just like Thomas Jefferson said - once we know our rights and we are active enough we can defend our lives, defend our families, our country, everything, once we have the knowledge. And the knowledge is genuine Common Law. This Common Law expression has been bandied around for years and misinterpreted. You've got to be very wary of the nasty characters who will take a word and corrupt it. You've got to know the truth. That is the most important thing. There's a legal maxim that says "*Truth is the mother of justice*" and that's what we all want. We all want justice for ourselves and everyone around us and love our neighbors. It's been a, a long hard battle and all I did was blow the whistle on the banks thirty years ago. Since then I've come across great opposition. Opposition from the hierarchy, from the elite, from the judiciary and so forth. They all ganged up because they want to conceal the truth and all I did was take one word to a Court. The one word was "*variable*" and that was it. Because under, under Contract Law you cannot have uncertainty in a contract and when you have variable interest rates that renders a contract void for uncertainty which blows the banks out of the water. All these mortgages and everybody thinks they have got to pay this variable interest rate and thinks "Oh, we don't know what we're going to pay next week.". That is all totally a hundred percent unlawful. So, I took that to Court and I found the Judges from the Supreme Court going onto the High Court concealed this. They lied. Judges in the Supreme Court said "*the rate is indeed certain*". I said "*No it's not. It's uncertain because it's variable.*" That was the beginning of it. Then when I started to realize how corrupt the judiciary was in conspiring with the banks to cover up the fraud. I kept on going right through to the High Court, and I've got all the transcripts. On the transcript in the High Court, I said "*One question. Does variable mean uncertain?*" And then three Judges, Dawson, Toohey and Kirby said "*We cannot answer that question. Dismissed.*"

JC: Wow.

JW: That's it. Hah, hah. And ...

JC: Wow.

JW: And then it all came into focus and I said "*Okay, I've got, I've got to get a jury*". I've go to go back to Court and get our Commonwealth system with Common Law and with trial by jury. There's no two ways about it. Common Law is trial by jury. Full stop. Without trial by jury we are at the disposal or at the mercy of really bad bastards who are the elite who are only interested in power and wealth using colonisation or anything at all. This has been going on for thousands of years. It's always been ordinary people fighting for their freedoms - whether by the War of Independence in America or the French Revolution or the English Civil War. It's all about fighting for sort of people power. And so all I've been doing has been trying to blow the whistle ...

JC: Mm hm.

JW: ... on the whole corrupt system. Even yesterday when we went to the Local Court with Brett the same thing was happening, you know.

JC: Yes.

JW: And as soon as you start standing up for your rights they strong-arm you out.

JC: Mm hm.

JW: They'll either force you out into the street or put you in a cell.

JC: Yes.

JW: This has been going on repeatedly.

JC: And what would you suggest if the best pla ... for ... 'cause you've been doing this for decades ...

JW: Yeah.

JC: ... and coping with this.

JW: Yes.

JC: What would you suggest for us newbies to be doing, the best way that we can stand up to help sort of start working together so that there's ... they're less able to strong-arm us and less able to throw us out of the Council meetings and all the rest of it?

JW: Well there's an old saying that "*There are four boxes to be used in defense of liberty: soap, ballot, jury, and ammo. Please use in that order.*". This is by a U.S. Senator fifty years ago. The first one is a soapbox which is make a lot of noise, write letters and bang drums and march up and down the street, and that that's the first box, the soapbox. And then when that doesn't work, you don't achieve what you want to do, then you go to the second box which is the ballot box which you elect people in to parliament to make good laws for you, for your protection and security. And when the parliament fails you've got the third box which is a powerful box which is the jury box because in the jury the people govern, the people have sovereignty, and that's how we exercise our power by trial by jury. So, you've got to get a jury in every single case no matter what the cause it. It can be the Local Court, the High Court, the Land and Environment Court, the Family Court. Every Court in the land you must have a jury as soon as you walk into the Court. You don't have to ask to, hah, hah, seek leave or anything like that. That is your inalienable right. And the only way a Judge or a Magistrate has got any jurisdiction is with your consent. Unless they get that consent, which is clear and unequivocal, they've got no jurisdiction and all those proceedings are null and void. But they don't, they just don't want to tell you that. And it's been that way in English history for many hundreds of years. The most important periods were possibly not only with Magna Carta, which was in the thirteenth century, but also in the seventeenth century when tyranny from the monarchy was becoming really nasty and the people would start to rebel. That's when they brought in the Petition of Right, the Bill of Rights, and all those good Acts of Parliament to defend us and to get rid of Star Chambers. The seventeenth century was a very dynamic period.

JC: What's Star Chambers, sorry?

JW: The Star Chamber was a Court in Kensington Palace with stars on the ceiling.

JC: Right.

JW: There the Judges were actually tyrants. They would not allow people to exercise their rights. They would not allow trial by jury and any lawyer who spoke up against them they got imprisoned. It was a very draconian court system. In fact they had to bring in an Act of Parliament to abolish the Star Chamber in 1640 and they described the Star Chamber Court as being "*an intolerable burden on the people and an arbitrary power of government*".

JC: Mm hm.

JW: So, the Judges were governing the people and this, this is unheard of because in a democracy it is the people who govern - and they don't want you to know that. They don't want you to know the truth in the law. So, as far as defending yourself you've got to know your fundamental rights, you've got to learn the lessons of history.

JC: Mm hm.

JW: There's an old saying, "*If you don't learn the lesson of history you're doomed to repeat it*".

JC: Repeat it.

JW: It's the same thing. Everybody falls asleep and the criminals and traitors come in and take over.

JC: Yeah.

JW: And so it's a matter of education and the spreading the gospel on the basis of truth.

JC: Yep.

JW: And then people will have the truth with which to defend themselves. So, that's three boxes already dealt with.

JC: Yeah.

JW: So the ...

JC: And the fourth ...

JW: So ...

JC: ... box?

JW: ... the fourth box is the ammo box.

JC: The ammo box.

JW: The ammo box.

JC: Hah, hah.

JW: We ...

JC: Hah, hah.

Male voice: That's the one we like.

JW: Well, the ...

JC: No. No. I'm a freedom ??? (*voices clashing*) ...

JW: ... No, no. I say no. Then ...

JC: We're still a bit ... we're, we're still hoping for the jury box though aren't we ???
(*voices clashing*) ...

JW: That's what you've got to hang onto because the moment we start to do silly things, they're going to be wiped out.

JC: Yes.

JW: ??? (*mumbling*)

JC: Yes.

JW: Because they've got more guns and tasers, etc., we've got to get some muscle. We've got to get some muscle of our own to enforce the third box.

JC: Yep.

JW: And that is with the Sheriffs.

JC: Yep.

JW: We must educate the Sheriffs that their true duty ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... their true duty is to defend our rights. I've got a copy of the Sheriffs Service Charter. A copy of the NSW Sheriffs' Service Charter, yes, and this is right. What they are doing is wrong.

Female voice: I'm just wondering ...

JW: This is what ?

Female voice: And the thing is ??? (*voices clashing*) ...

JC: ... Um, nah. Well we won't say names. But he gets persecuted because he's trying to do the right thing and trying to protect people and trying to let people know and so the thing is some folk are getting hounded ...

JW: Mm.

JC: ... because they're standing up. And the thing is you've been putting up with this and having to push back against it for decades. Well obviously you're very strong, stoic character. The thing is though a lot of, a lot of folk aren't able to cope with that

on an ongoing basis that, you know, having Police and Sheriffs and that visit them at home and all ...

Female voice: Yeah.

JC: ... this sort of intimidation.

Female voice: That's right.

JC: And the thing is as soon as people stand up they want to squash them because they want ... they, they don't want anyone getting away with anything because then ...

JW: They want total control.

JC: ... they think oh, someone else is gonna stand up so we really need to come down hard. But how do you get enough people to rise up so that there's too many? And where, and where's ... what's the best things, the actual thing, actual actions we can take to start off with so that as, as the sort of a group of people we can stand up?

JW: You should start with the Magna Carta. You've gotta learn one particular passage in Magna Carta which says it all. It is the focus of our democracy, and that, that phrase is I think forty three words long. It says that "*No free man, I emphasize, no free man shall be taken indeed imprisoned or exiled or outlawed or dispossessed or destroyed in any way nor should we pass over him nor shall we send over him unless by the lawful judgement of his equals which is the law of the land*". And once people begin to ...

JC: Grasp that.

JW: ... grasp that ...

Male voice: Yeah. You make it ...

JW: ... because every word has been measured and it means what it says. Once we understand all the basic rights are in that one small passage ...

JC: Yes, yes.

JW: ... and I have a little card which I give out to people and tell them this should be taught to third classes in primary school.

JC: Yes.

JW: because that is the foundation of our democracy. We've got to learn the true meaning of the words. And once you have the truth on your side, then you go about

putting it into effect and we've got to have the muscle to do it because, at the moment, they have the might and they are brutal ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... and that they have been putting me in jail so many times. I've been in jail about seven times already ...

JC: Wow.

JW: ... the last time was last year and it was nearly three months.

JC: Wow.

JW: They disregard everything and it's all done by what are called Kangaroo Courts ...

JC: Yep.

JW: ... which is today is equivalent to the Star Chamber ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... which is an arbitrary power of government.

JC: Yes.

JW: They are governing us in our Courts

JC: Yes.

JW: ... so that we've got to say "*Hang on! Hang on!. These are our Courts!*"

JC: Yes.

JW: But they think that they are their Courts. They think our Courts are their Corporation Courts ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... and you've got to blow the whistle and you say "*No. That is untrue*".

JC: Right.

JW: Because everything's only done with our consent ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... the consent of the people. That's where the power is. But we've got to know how to put that into place. When you've got a Kangaroo Court..... and Kangaroo Court is by definition "*a Court that acts unfairly ...*

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... *or dishonestly ...*

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... *or disregards legal rights or disregards legal procedures*".

JC: Uh huh.

JW: So, the point of it is already there. We've got to Challenge the Jurisdiction of the Court, and this is a legal procedure.

JC: Right.

JW: When you go to Court and they say "*Oh no. You haven't got any trial by jury here*". You say "*I Challenge the Jurisdiction of the Court*" - which is a legal procedure.

JC: Right.

JW: International! And, as soon as you Challenge the Jurisdiction of the Court, there is a mandatory or peremptory stay of proceedings.

JC: Right.

JW: It all stops. Everything stops until the Sheriff impounds a jury to determine the Jurisdiction of the Court. In other words, a jury will decide if you've got the right to trial by jury and that is checkmate.

JC: Okay.

JW: And they know that.

JC: Okay. So, what ...

JW: And they won't allow that.

JC: Okay. So, I've got a couple of, couple of questions then. Over in Western Australia, Rod Culleton, he ...

JW: Yeah, yeah.

JC: They've been, you know, trying to get fair dinkum Sheriffs.

JW: Yeah.

JC: So, is that along the lines of what you're talking about? And then my other question is when they call you for jury duty here ...

JW: Yeah.

JC: ... so what are those people there going ... they're like they're ... that's our fellow people here. They're going to jury duty. So, what's the story with that?

JW: When you go for jury service or duty, you've got to know what a jury is and how it's supposed to function.

JC: Mm hm.

JW: And basically a jury..... they are the law.

JC: Yes.

JW: They are the law. In fact there is a beautiful scene in a Hollywood movie with Paul Newman is called "*The Verdict*" and he stood in front of the jury and he said "*First of all you are the law!*" And that's dead right - because the jury is the law.

JC: Mm hm.

JW: Jury is the word from the Latin "*iuris*" that means "*right, law, oath*". So, you've got to take it on board that the jury is democracy. I've got T-shirts saying "*Trial by jury is democracy. Use it or lose it.*" and that jury's got to be a fully informed jury.

JC: The juries that ... so when I get called for jury duty or anyone does, is it possible that we could give them that information so then when they're acting as a jury member that they actually are acting ethically and legitimately in which case then the Corporation Court would have to obey them?

JW: They've got to know that. They issue the Court Orders so that "*a Court is a place where justice is administered*" where rights are protected and wrongs are punished. Okay? That's the definition of a Court. So, what constitutes a Court? In a democracy we have trial by jury. In other words it is not a Court unless it has Common Law juries ... and that jury has got to know what they're doing. So, we've got to educate them. Thomas Jefferson said years ago "*If people don't know how to govern themselves, then educate them*". It's all about education. That's the idea of my book ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... to educate.

JC: Yeah.

JW: And even the law students have got to be educated because the law students are being corrupted ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... into a system which is totally undemocratic and does not allow the people to have a life of enabled rights.

JC: Right.

JW: So, it's all a matter of education and arguing real law over many, many years and blowing the whistle. And after I had that incident in the High Court where they refused to tell the truth and so expose the fraud of the banks which would have cost the banks hundreds of billions of dollars ...

JC: Mm.

JW: ... and people would get their homes back.

JC: John would've been a four letter word then, wouldn't it?

JW: Hah, hah.

JC: Hah, hah.

Male voice: Yeah.

JW: You've got to have the strength and knowledge, and knowledge is power. Even the bible says that people are destroyed for the lack of knowledge.

JC: ??? (*mumbling*)

JW: So, it's all a matter of knowledge and ...

JC: ... ??? (*voices clashing*)

JW: Yeah. That's right. Yep. So, we, we've got to educate. And when you have a jury, that jury is supposed to know what they're doing. There's a beautiful essay written two hundred years ago by a Barrister in America called "*An Essay on Trial by Jury 1852*" by Lysander Spooner, and he encapsulates everything, the whole system. It's

as current today as it was then. You've got to have a jury who know their rights and responsibilities.

JC: Two actions that we could possibly start looking at doing is in a short version like a ... so that we can try and give people that are, go on juries here, the information that they need to actually act legitimately ... and also with that, what Rod Culleton's doing in Western Australia with the Sheriffs and that over there, is that possible that ... would that be worthwhile us trying to do that here so that we've got actual legitimate Sheriffs? Because I think you, you ... any, any, any of us people can stand up and be that, can't we? So, would those two actions be helpful here?

JW: Well, it's the same thing in that as far as Rod Culleton's concerned. He came to me quite a few years ago and he asked me what to do.

JC: Good.

JW: And I said first of all you, you've got to ignore these repossessions. Go back on your property. And he did.

JC: Right.

JW: Hah, hah, and God knows for a period he used to phone me and oh, he would talk for hours and hours.

JC: Yep.

JW: One time when he was the Senator, I went with him to the High Court and, when those three Judges started proceeding with all this Star Chamber nonsense, I actually stood up in the High Court with quite a few hundred people there and said, "*This is a Star Chamber. You were abolished years ago*" and walked out. So, Rod and I know each other very well. And what he's doing, he's trying to set up Common Law Sheriffs but this is alien to ordinary people because ordinary people know there are Sheriffsbut they don't know the Sheriffs are being corrupted and so, we've got to un-corrupt the Sheriffs. We've got to win back the Sheriffs and then we've got the muscle.

JC: Alright.

JW: Because, rather than muscle being used by the other side to throw us out and suppress us, we use the same muscle to enforce our rights and put them in prison.

JC: Right.

JW: So, it's all down to educating the Sheriffs.

JC: Okay. Good. Now, well then a question on that then is some people here have had visits by the Sheriffs ...

JW: Yeah.

JC: ... here which strongarm and they appear to be completely indoctrinated in the, in the system and they're also getting paid by the corporation part of the system.

JW: Yep.

JC: So, if, if they find out that they actually ought to be doing this to be ethical and legitimate then the corporation system probably will stop paying them ...

JW: Yeah.

JC: ... and then they'll be, then they'll be with us. So, would it be easier perhaps like I see over there that they've got like a hundred or so Common Law Sheriffs that are just volunteers. They don't get paid. They just do the right thing. Is that a possibility or is that too hard a thing?

JW: No. It's not right. It's not right ...

JC: Okay. So, what ...

JW: The system is there ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... and it's a good system. It's a ...

JC: Right.

JW: ... Common Law system ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... based upon the Sheriffs.

JC: Okay.

JW: And it's the Sheriffs who are the chief law enforcement officers.

JC: Yep. Okay.

JW: Their job is set out in their latest Service Charter ...

JC: Yep.

JW: ... it says very clearly their duty is to uphold ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... the fundamental right to trial by jury. It's ...

JC: Right.

JW: ... in those very words ...

JC: Right.

JW: ... and I talk to the Sheriffs and they say I've never read it, you know.

JC: Okay.

JW: Therefore you are not Sheriffs because you don't know what you're doing ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... and they are being used in corrupt ways for evil purposes.

JC: Yes.

JW: And I say to them, "*Learn what you're supposed to do!*".

JC: Alright.

JW: We've got to educate the Sheriffs.

JC: What if there is people ... so we've had people that have been visited, visited by these Sheriffs.

JW: Yeah.

JC: Now they are not listening at all and they're not wanting to be educated because they're quite happy being in the corporation, being paid, and carrying out these illegal orders.

JW: Mm.

JC: So, how, how do you re-educate someone that, that doesn't want to, to know the truth?

JW: Well, as far as educating the Sheriffs, you just pull out a copy of their Service Charter their own Service Charter ...

JC: Right.

JW: ... and I think on page eight or nine it says very clearly what they're supposed to do. There it is, in their own Charter. You can read those, those words down there?

JC: It's got here "*Our mission is to protect the New South Wales justice system, upholding the integrity of the justice system through equal access to justice and safe orderly court premises.*" And then down here, "*Administering the jury system that supports the criminal justice system and the fundamental right to trial by jury supporting the rule of law in New South Wales.*" Wow. Hah.

JW: And they've never read it. Quite a few years ago, I was corresponding with an America Sheriff.

JC: Yeah.

JW: Do you know about this American Sheriff? He's called Richard Mack.

JC: Yep.

JW: And he's got his own organization in America and he's convincing the American Sheriffs to be true to their oath. It's called, it's called "*Oath Keepers.*"

JC: Yes.

JW: And so Richard I tried to get him out here ...

JC: Yeah, yeah.

JW: ... to talk to the Sheriffs ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... because he was a Sheriff ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... and he's a very wonderful man. I wish I could bring him out here because ...

Female voice: name?

JW: ... he would be ...

JC: Richard Mack. M-A-C-K?

JW: Yeah. Richard Mack.

JC: Mack.

JW: You'll find him on the internet and so forth.

JC: Great.

JW: We've got to educate the Sheriffs.

JC: Mm hm.

JW: And that they resist ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... because they're not real bright. Hah, hah.

JC: Hah, hah. Well I suppose they're indoctrinated, aren't they?

JW: Because all they are doing just following orders.

JC: Following orders.

JW: Yeah. So, they're ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... just following orders and they're not really intelligent. I call them morons and imbeciles and other un-nice things. Basically, you don't know what you're doing.

JC: No.

JW: Sheriff is an old English word that means the Shire Reeve. He is the, the right hand man of the King to enforce the King's Orders and it still continues today.

JC: Yeah.

JW: In every courthouse they must have Sheriffs.

JC: Right.

JW: And the Sheriffs have more power than the Judges ...

JC: Wow.

JW: ... but they don't know that.

Male voice: So, the King's, the King's Men ?

JC: Wow.

JW: They are the King's Men. So, in other words when the ...

JC: ... It's a whole new world, isn't it?

JW:when the Judges ...

JC: Not the New World Order though. Hah, hah.

JW:when the Judges go wrong ...

JC: Yep.

JW: ... the Sheriffs have got to step in ...

JC: Yep.

JW: ... and take command ... because their job is to ensure the integrity of the justice system.

JC: Yes.

JW: And when they the Judges are judging or violating the laws ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... then it's the role of the Sheriffs to step in. We don't need to go any further. Enforce the third box which is the Jury Box.

JC: Yes.

JW: It all comes back to knowing and showing them that "*Juries R Us*".

JC: Yes.

JW: That means that juries are us. It means that we the people are the law.

JC: Yeah.

JW: We the people are the law.

JC: Yes.

JW: With that information you've got the power. But you've got to put it into effect. No backing off because they'll intimidate you and they'll put you in jail. Hah, hah. They will do all sorts of nasty things to you.....and you've got to expose. On my website I've got several videos, and one video was where the Sheriff comes to my surgery ... and I had this confrontation with the Sheriff at the door of my surgery.

JC: Yes.

JW: I said, "*You don't know what you're doing. You've got to obey the law.*" My website's got probably half a dozen videos and so forth ... all specific ... I'm trying to teach people ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... how they can still defend themselves because it's all down to knowledge. I had to do the research in the first place because when I realised that things were wrong ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... 'cause when I realized that the banks were wrong ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... the first thing I did was go to the Law Library and do the research. When you do the research you've got the information and then you put it into place. You can't go off half-cocked and say ...

JC: No.

JW: ... silly things.

JC: 'Cause they'll ...

JW: And don't misinterpret anything ... stick to the truth. That's why I've got the website. People don't know about even the Court forms.

JC: Yep.

JW: Brett and I've done it several times. You put in a Requisition for Trial by Jury.

JC: Right.

JW: Now that is not a request. A requisition is “*a demand for something by virtue of a right*”.

JC: Yes.

JW: That’s what it means ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... so there’s no question. Every time you go to Court, it doesn’t matter if it’s a speeding fine or murder. If you feel “*Oh, yes. I was illegally parked but it’s not worth four hundred dollars*”. Okay.

JC: Yep.

JW: If you go to Court and say “*Yeah, fair enough. I’ve done it but it’s not with a guilty mind and this punishment doesn’t fit the crime*”. It is a jury..... they judge the law ...

JC: Mm hm.

JW: ... the jury judge the law and the facts and the jury determines the punishment. The jury decides, when the Council wants to impose four hundred dollars fine, “*Oh, no. It’s worth ten dollars*”. The jury is the most powerful institution. You’ve got to use the system as it is intended to be used.

JC: Yes. Not, not try and reinvent a new system. The system is there. It’s just that it’s been corrupted.

JW: One hundred per cent.

JC: We need to start using it and starting to try to educate those ones that are in that system so that they’re using it properly as well.

Female voice: Absolutely.

JW: The important thing is you, you concentrate on Challenging the Jurisdiction.

JC: Righteo.

JW: And you do that in Court ...

JC: Yep.

JW: ... by mouth. You say “*Hang on, hang on. Things are going wrong here. I Challenge the Jurisdiction of the Court.*” And when you say that you back it up with the written reasons why. I have composed this thing called an “*Affidavit of Written Reasons of Challenge to the Jurisdiction of the Court by ...*” as an example and I would like people to spread it around and use that as a template because in that it’s got all the essence of the law ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... and how the Courts are supposed to perform.

JC: Yes.

JW: And when you put that before a Court ... as soon as you Challenge the Jurisdiction of the Court, there must be a jury empanelled to determine the evidence of the Challenge because when you challenge you deny and “*The burden is on the one who affirms and not on the one who denies*”. So, when you deny that the Court has Jurisdiction, they have got to prove that they do..... and they have got to prove their commission. Even their commission is fraud ...

JC: Yep.

JW: ... because people don’t know the importance of the word Commonwealth.

JC: Yeah.

JW: Because in the Commonwealth, in the Commonwealth there is no King.

JC: Yep. Yeah.

JW: That’s the important thing. This lesson goes back to the seventeenth century, again, when they chopped off King Charles 1’s head because of high treason ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... and then once they dispose of the King’s head ...

JC: Yep.

JW: ... then they brought an Act of Parliament to Abolish the Office of King.

JC: Wow.

JW: They abolished ...

JC: Wow.

JW: ... the Office of King and as soon as they abolished the Office of King ...

JC: Yep.

JW: ... they then declared, by an Act of Parliament, they declared England "*to be a Commonwealth* ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... *and Free-State.....without any King or House of Lords*" So, in a Commonwealth, and we've been a Commonwealth since 1901 ...

JC: Wow.

JW: ... that this fiction, this fraud, this lie ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... that we are under a Monarchy of another country is such a big lie.

JC: Yeah.

JW: And the elites have been using this lie to rape the country ...

JC: Yeah.

JW: ... and destroy any resistance. Anybody who dissents, hah, they'll come down heavily. But you've got to have courage or whatever you want to call.

JC: Yeah.

JW: That you've got to stand up ...

JC: Yep.

JW: ... 'cause of the bully.

JC: Yeah.

JW: The same as in the playground.

JC: That's right.

JW: Yeah. If you're on the swing and some bully comes along and pushes you off, you know, you don't take that.

JC: No. The, the thing is what we need is all the other children in the playground to come and ...

JW: Yeah.

JC: ... harass the bully. So John, that's probably a bit over half an hour that we're putting on the thing and thank you so much for all the information. We've obviously all got a lot of study and learning to do, and also sharing information. Are there any ... for this interview for us to put it up, are there any last comments you'd like to say before we finish off the interview?

JW: Well, the importance is we do have a very good system..... a system to protect individuals and their rights and so forthbut you've got to know it, though.

JC: Yes.

JW: You've got to know what your rights are.

JC: Yes.

JW: If you don't know your rights you have none.

JC: Yes.

JW: So, it's all about education and finding out for yourself.

JC: Yes.

JW: And if you think it's not right, your conscience will say it's not right. Even the RSL says, "*The Price of Liberty is Eternal Vigilance.*"

JC: Yes.

JW: You can say it in so many different ways.

JC: Yeah.

JW: They're all alarms to wake up and realize what, what is being done ...

JC: Yes.

JW: ... not only to yourself but your family and your country. and it all comes out in a battle between good and evil.

JC: Yes.

JW: Hah, hah.

JC: Exactly. And we're, and we're standing up. And John, thank you so much for carrying the baton for so long for so many of us, and hopefully we're all going to get very busy now and start running the relay ourselves, and the more we learn and the quicker we learn it the better. Then we can all stand up to the bullies. Spread the word and thank you so much for all the information you've brought up and we will be distributing these at our time???. And we're going to clap? (*clapping sounds*)

JW: Hah, hah.

JC: Thank you very much John. We love you. Thank you.
